Supplement Notes

The blood recovered from Steven Jones was sent to the AZ Department of Public Safety Crime Laboratory for analysis of BAC and Drug content. The results of these tests were returned to me and indicated no alcohol or drugs.

During the course of this investigation, requests for medical records were sent to the Flagstaff Medical Center for the three victims hospitalized in this case. Detective Jacobellis from the Flagstaff Police Department completed requests for Nicholas Piring and Nicholas Prato during the initial part of the investigation while they were in the Emergency Room. These records were sent to him, and he provided me with these records, which I turned over to Evidence Technician Wigley, who placed them into evidence. I completed a request for Kyle Zientek after he was released, and received these records from Flagstaff Medical Center, which again were given to Evidence Technician Wigley for placement into evidence. Please see her evidence records for further.

I reviewed the medical report for Nicholas Prato, which documents the bullet wound [REDACTED]. This report also documents the laboratory work that was completed on Prato. The lab report indicates that Piring's BAC was .092 and further indicated a positive result for Cannabis. Please refer to this report for complete details.

I reviewed the medical report for Kyle Zientek, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The laboratory reports for Zientek indicate a BAC of .181 and a positive indication for Cannabis. Please refer to this report for complete details.

I reviewed the medical report for Nicholas Piring, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The lab reports indicate a BAC of .208. The drug screening of Piring's lab results were not included in this report, and follow up with FMC records will be conducted for these results. Please refer to this report for complete details.

On 11/20/2015 I contacted the Coconino County Medical Examiner's Office in reference to the progress of Colin Brough's autopsy. I was told the final report was not complete, but should be done soon. I asked if the toxicology report was back, and they indicated it

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was. They explained that the report showed a BAC of .285 and also showed positive for "THC". I will provide more details, when the final report is completed.

Nothing further at this time. I will continue to supplement this report as further details are gathered.
